

WAFM Indoor Market Application 2020-2021

Wolfeboro Area Farmers Market is excited to invite vendors to join us for the 2020-2021 Indoor Market Season!

This year's Indoor Market will be held from 10am - 1pm on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month starting 7 November until 17 April, at the Brookfield Town Hall, 267 Wentworth Rd, Brookfield, NH 03872.

Purpose – The purpose of the Wolfeboro Area Farmers Market (WAFM) is to promote local agriculture by providing a marketplace wherein locally grown, raised, and/or processed food and farm products are for sale to the public and where educational exhibitions pertaining thereto may be given.

Local – WAFM defines “local” as any product grown or produced in NH or within 50 miles of Wolfeboro.

Fees – Given the extenuating circumstances of this year, the winter market will be a flat rate of \$15 per market, paid on the day of the market. There is no additional fee to use the kitchen, but you must clean up after yourself.

Annual Membership Dues – The annual membership dues are \$15.00 per vendor. If you were a summer vendor, you have already paid the annual dues and you do not need to pay again.

Insurance – ALL WAFM Vendors are ****REQUIRED**** to carry a Commercial General Liability Insurance Policy of at least \$1,000,000 prior to being allowed to vend. A Certificate of Insurance must be submitted within ten (10) business days of the applicant being accepted as a vendor. The Certificate Holder information must read “Wolfeboro Area Farmers Market, 267 Wentworth Rd, Brookfield, NH 03872”

*****Vendors will NOT be allowed to set up at the market if there is no Certificate of Insurance on file.*****

ALL VENDORS ARE REQUIRED TO CARRY A COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY POLICY of \$1,000,000 prior to being allowed to vend. A Certificate of Additional Insured must be submitted at least 15 days prior to the vendor's first market. The Certificate Holder information must read "Wolfeboro Area Farmers Market, 267 Wentworth Rd, Brookfield, NH 03872"

WAFM will accept applications from farmers first and then from crafters as we have room. Farmers will be allowed to bring their own crafts to the market; however, crafts may not exceed 50% of your products if you apply as a farm. (Unless crafts are purely agricultural in nature.)
